#### TFT Members,

The TFT dues schedule for 2020-2021 will be as follows, with very little to no change from last year

- Full time \$825.00 o ¾ time (.75-.99) \$618.75 o ½ time (.5 .74) \$412.50 o
   Categorical employees and PD Subs 1% of contract amount no less than \$100 and no more than \$185.
- o ATA \$133
- o Building Substitutes \$412.50
- Coaches (\$30 per sport) This \$30 will only cover AFT benefits including liability insurance for duration of season coached. Coaches can opt to pay \$90 total to cover these benefits the entire year.

ACH deductions will be on the first pay of each month for the months October – June. September's dues will be taken out on the 2<sup>nd</sup> paycheck. No dues will be collected in July and August.

\*\*New hires dues deduction will start the month they were hired unless they were hired after the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month, in which case dues will start the following month. Dues are pro-rated based on the number of months you work for that school year.
